## Brookland Junior School – School Uniform and PE Uniform

**Children will need to wear school uniform 3 days a week and their PE uniform 2 days a week.**

### School Uniform – to be worn on non-PE days (3 days a week)

- Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan/fleece (school logo optional)
- Light blue polo shirt (school logo optional)
- Dark grey trousers, shorts
- Dark grey skirt (knee-length), or pinafore dress
- Blue and white striped or checked dress for summer
- Sensible all black shoes, suitable for school with no colourful soles, brand logos or coloured laces
- Wellington boots for OPAL lunchtimes
- Sensible coat for daily school use and time of year - no fur, no leather
- Wellies - needed for everyday for our OPAL outdoor provision

We also expect them to adopt a suitable, age appropriate hairstyle. We actively discourage extreme hairstyles. We consider extremes to be, hair colouring, and dying and logos/patterns shaven into the hair.

Nail varnish, make up and tattoo/transfers, fake nails and eye lashes are also not allowed.

Long hair should be tied back and headbands and clips should be simple and coloured blue to match the uniform. No other elaborate hair accessories should be worn e.g. no Jo-Jo bows.

### PE Uniform – to be worn on PE days (2 days a week)

- A pair of plain black/navy blue shorts/skorts
- Plain White T-shirt (school logo optional)
- Plain black/navy blue tracksuit bottoms or leggings
- School jumper/cardigan or plain black/navy blue jumper/cardigan (no hoodies)
- Trainers – either plain black, navy or white – no bright colours

Due to health and safety regulations, we do not allow jewellery to be worn in school, except for **watches (not smart watches) and plain ear studs.**

Ear studs must be removed for PE lessons or covered with micropore tape. Micropore tape is available from pharmacies and it is parents' responsibility to ensure that their child has this in school if needed. We recommend that all jewellery is removed and left at home on PE days.
