




Put the new words into sentences.</p> 	<p>Please complete <b>page 19 (Estimating)</b> of your KS2 CGP maths mental workout book.</p>  <p>We will go through the answers in class on Thursday.</p> <p>Log in to Times Table Rockstars and practise your times tables up to 12 x 12.</p>

**Year 5:**

There is a new book scheduled called:</p> <p><b>Lily Parr - Football Star</b></p> <p>Read <b>Chapter 6</b> and then complete the activities after.</p> 	<p>Please complete <b>question 3 and 4 on page 27</b> of your KS2 CGP grammar book.</p>  <p>Spelling: practice the spelling words from the Year 5/6 curriculum list: communicate, community, competition, conscience, conscious</p>	<p>Please complete <b>questions 1 and 2 on page 1</b> of your KS2 CGP maths mental workout book.</p>  <p>We will go through the answers in class on Thursday. Practise your 12 times tables.</p>
