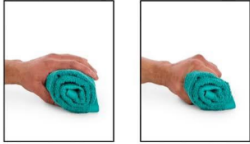

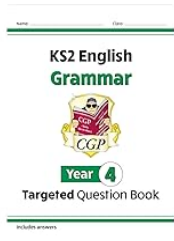
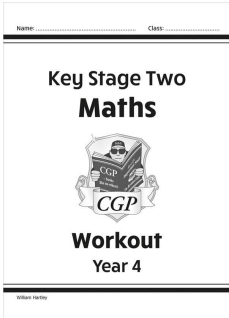
Year 2:

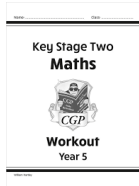
Year 3:
