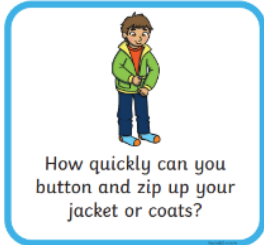

Reception:

Phonics	Finger Strong	Communication & Language
Practice initial letter sounds by spotting objects around the house that start with the same sound. This week we have learned the sounds: i, n, m, d 	This week, we would like you to try out this challenge. 	Play guess the Sound: Gather household items like keys, plastic bags, or spoons. Let your child look at them, then turn around while you make a sound. Ask them to name the object and describe if the sound was loud or quiet.

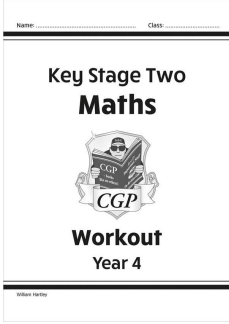
Year 2:
