

Overview of Religious Education Units.

At Brookland Junior School the children study Christianity in every year group along with at least one other major world religion or worldview. The eight key areas of RE (Hertfordshire Agreed Syllabus) must be visited across each key stage and are: Beliefs and Practices, Sources of Wisdom, Symbols and actions, Prayer, worship and reflection, Identity and belonging, Ultimate questions and Justice and fairness.
