The children have already started to rehearse their song with the teacher and it is sounding really good.

The children will be travelling from Haileybury Turnford via minibus to Haileybury private school, which is near Hoddesdon. The concert will be taking place in the cathedral, which is on the school grounds. Unfortunately, the event is just for children from across different schools and therefore parents and carers are not able to attend.

The children will be leaving at 9.30am and returning to Brookland at 1.30pm. Therefore, your child will need a packed lunch.
