### Year 3

- **Artist – Henry Moore**
- Create a poster of his life and works
- Choose a favourite piece of his work and evaluate – using correct vocabulary.
- Use clay to create own sculptures
- **Artist – Jacob Burmood**
- Create a sculpture with draped fabric and paint (display for children to copy)

### Year 4

- **Artist – Alberto Giacometti**
- Create an infographic about his life and works.
- Learn how metal is moulded.
- Work with clay/plaster pipe cleaners and foil to manipulate material to understand this process.
- Choose a sculpture and recreate it.

### Year 5

- **Artist – Ferry Staveman's cardboard sculptures**
  - Study his sculptures and recreate a similar sculpture
  - Explore recycled (stacked) card sculptures
  - **Study the work of David Stark**
  - Recreate a similar sculpture
  - Compare, contrast and evaluate two sculptural processes

  - Using clay, create an item of Viking jewellery

- Explore kinetic sculptures
- Consider how movement can be achieved
- Sketch ideas for own sculpture
