Meet the teacher presentations

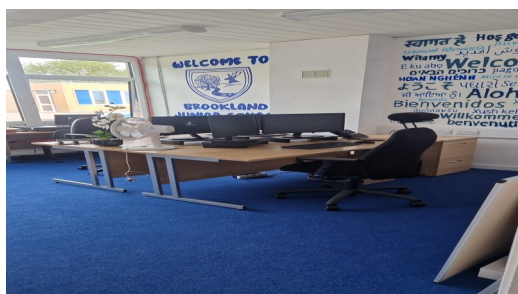
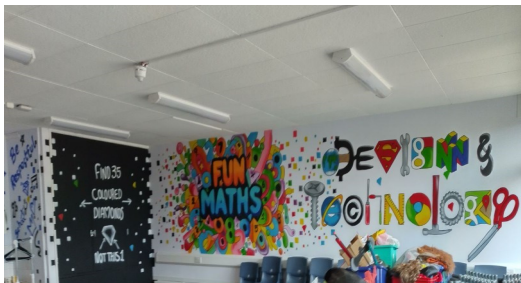
