Happy Half Term

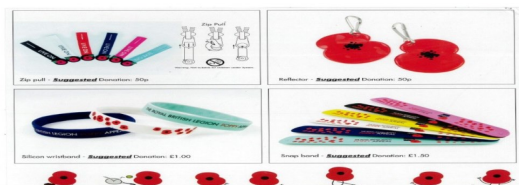
