This week, we have had a science focus across the school to celebrate national science week's theme of change and adapt. Year 3 had fun creating the moon phases out of Oreos. The white cream represented the moon's bright side. The children were able to link this to the theme of change. Year 4 children have shown their understanding by incorporating other curriculum areas; including PE, music and science. Year 5 have used the idea of 'change and adapt' to grow rainbows, understand how animals adapt to underwater habitats and how games and activities can be modified to suit the needs of those who participate. Year 6 created fabulous posters about animals evolving, changing and adapting to their environments, using their prior knowledge of Charles Darwin's research.
