# Osmington Bay



## Accommodation

- En suite chalets sleep 4 to 6 children
- 2 or 3 sets of bunk beds
- Children can pick children (from the same sex) from any of the 3 classes
- Children are guaranteed at least one child they want to share with from their list
- They will be allocated their rooms on arrival at PGL
- Adults rooms are amongst the children's rooms so children have access to the adults at all times

# Payment

The cost will be £335 per child (twin discount available) and includes accommodation, bedding, food, all activities and transport.

2. Final payment of £280 to be made by **Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2026 - This payment will open from 1st September 2025.**

You can pay in instalments anytime between these dates.

# FAQ's



- **Why not Monday to Friday?** A lot cheaper
- **How many adults go?** Depending on number of children going but usually at least 1 adult to 10 children
- **What to take?** – kit list will be given out nearer the time- Old clothing is the best! Please label everything and pack with your child.
- **Pocket money?** – £10 there is a shop, mainly sweets and knick-knacks
- **Contacting your child?** - communication is done through the school (mobile number to be given for out of hours)
- **Children not going to PGL?** will be in school as timetable
- **What if my child has medical needs?** - we will meet with you closer to the date of going to put together a medical plan for your child.
