

BROOKLAND JUNIOR SUNSET CLUB

A healthy light tea will be provided which will include:

Sandwiches, buns, wraps or crackers with a choice of fillings.

Fruit Juice, water and a biscuit, a choice of fresh fruit & veg (daily), yoghurt and cake.

Once a month hot dogs/beans on toast. We are always open to requests from children.

Payment

All sessions must be paid for in advance via Arbor or directly into the school bank account. A child's absence will not result in a refund/credit unless long term illness or hospitalisation can be proved. Failure to make prompt payment may result in your child's name being withdrawn from the register.

All staff are skilled and trained and have been checked for their suitability to work with children. Staff plan

the activities for children to have fun and learn whilst playing. Activities include games, puzzles, construction toys, imaginative play, crafts such as painting, drawing, origami, Nintendo switches and tablets. Outside facilities including gym equipment, ball games and scooters.

A trained paediatric first aider is always available at the club.

The club expects and will encourage children to behave responsibly, to respect and be kind to both staff and each other. The club follows Brookland Junior School's behaviour policy.

Children will be signed in once they have walked to the Sunset Club at the end of the school day.

Brookland Junior Sunset Club - Terms and Conditions.

Admissions:

It is a requirement that all members of Brookland Junior Sunrise Club must have a fully completed application form before they begin sessions. Any changes to information held on the application form must be notified email to breakfastafterschool@brooklandjm.herts.sch.uk

When places are limited; children will be admitted according to the following:

- Children who will attend five days per week
- Siblings attending Brookland Junior School
- In order of receipt of a completed registration form

If you no longer require a place you **must** be communicated this to breakfastafterschool@brooklandjm.herts.sch.uk

Payment terms:

Sessions will operate in school term times only from 3.10pm – 6:00pm

Parents must commit to arranged times and days. On your application you will book the days you require your child to attend Sunrise Club and we regret that all absences must be paid for. Parents will be invoiced for the next half term, via Arbor based on the information given on the booking sheet.

1. All sessions must be paid for in advance. A child's absence will not result in a refund/credit unless long term illness or hospitalisation can be proved.
2. Failure to make prompt payment may result in your child's name being withdrawn from the register.
3. All additional sessions requested by parents/carers are subject to availability and need to be booked in advance.

The published daily rate will be applied to provide best value for parents, to allow for all costs to be met including staff costs, premises costs, provision of resources and activities and provision of food for the children. The club will be non-profit making but charges will have to be sufficient so that all costs are covered. The club will not be allowed to be run on a deficit budget.

Responsibilities:

Children will be registered to Sunset Club as they arrive, this is in case of emergency so that the club is aware of all children who are on site between the 3:10pm and 6:00pm, and who are members of the Brookland Junior Sunset Club.

Safety and Behaviour:

To enable all children to have fun safely, there is a behaviour expectation. The club expects, and will encourage children to behave responsibly and to show respect and be kind to both staff and each other. Children are expected to respond to requests from staff. Refusal to follow instruction and/or persistent anti-social behaviour could disrupt the club for other children. Consequently, the club reserves the right to terminate membership. The club follows the behaviour policy set out by Brookland Junior School.

Sickness absence:

A child's absence will not result in a refund/credit unless long term illness or hospitalisation can be proved. We regret that all absences must be paid for. Parents will be invoiced for the next half term based on the information given on the booking sheet. Invoices are generated by Arbor.

Absences due to family holiday taken in term will also have to be paid for.
