Year 6 Calendar of End of Year Events

Dear Year 6 Parents and Carers,

Please see below a list of key dates/events which will be taking place in the final few weeks of the academic year for all Year 6 children.

- **Friday 4th July - Monday 7th July** - PGL for those children attending. Children not attending, to be in school as normal.
- **Tuesday 8th July and Wednesday 9th July** - Children who attended PGL to have their weekend paid back so are not in school. Children who are not attending PGL to be in school as normal.
- **Thursday 10th July** – Moving-Up day - children will be spending the day at their new secondary school. The secondary school should have sent you details about this.
- **Monday 14th July - 6.30pm** – 1st performance to parents/carers.
- **Tuesday 15th July - 1pm** – 2nd performance to parents/carers.
- **Tuesday 15th July - 6.30pm** - 3rd performance to parents/ carers.

There will be a separate letter sent out with more information including how tickets can be purchased for the performances. Please note that there will be 3 tickets allocated to each child.

- **Wednesday 16th July** - Year 6 Prom - organised by parents on school playground/field.
- **Friday 18th July** - please send in plastic bags so children can take home books and artwork.
- **Friday 18th July** - Careers Fair organised by Mr Pugh (during school time) – further details to follow.
- **Friday 18th July** - Reports sent out to parents including KS2 SATs results for year 6 pupils.
- **Monday 21st July** - there will be 3 separate class leavers' assemblies at the following times:
Aspen class - 9am
Cedar class - 10:15am
Elder class - 11:30am
We will be able to accommodate a maximum of 4 adults per child to attend the assembly. Pre-school siblings are welcome too.
- **Monday 21st July** - Children can bring in a shirt/t-shirt to be signed by other pupils and staff. **It should be a separate shirt/t-shirt and not the top they are wearing to school on this day.**
- **Tuesday 22nd July** - is the **last day** for your child at primary school! Year 6 will leave at **11am** (earlier than the rest of the school). We will send the children off in style and we ask that you assemble ready to meet the children by the zebra crossing between the infant and junior school.
