As well as this, we are also encouraging children to '**Wear Odd Socks**' on the same day (Friday 14th November) as part of national anti-bullying week. On this day, participants are encouraged to wear mismatched socks as a symbol of uniqueness and to promote acceptance of diversity.

Our children, during their PSHE lessons, will be learning the following as a part of anti-bullying week:

- Year 1 – Will be focusing on how powerful kindness can be by creating kindness logos or superheroes.
- Year 2 – Will be focusing on how powerful kindness can be by creating kindness superheroes or kindness logos.
- Year 3 – Will be focusing on how kindness is spread by using kind hands and words during the school day.
- Year 4 - Will be focusing on receiving kindness and making fortune-tellers to spread kindness.
