




## Year 3:

<p>The children are expected to read for at least <b>10 minutes</b> a day for at least three times a week.</p> <p>Please sign your child's reading record.</p> <p>The children are expected to bring in their school reading book and reading records everyday.</p> <p>Book changes will be made on Tuesday and Fridays each week.</p> <p>Read a non-fiction book of your choice and write down 5 facts you have learnt.</p> 	<p>Please complete <b>page 7</b> in your English Grammar book.</p>  <p>The focus is using articles a or an in front of a word.</p> <p>Use "a" before words that start with a consonant sound, and "an" before words that start with a vowel sound.</p> <p>The rule is about the <b>sound</b> the word makes, not just the letter it starts with.</p> <p>For example, "a" is used before "cat" (consonant sound) and "an" is used before "apple" (vowel sound).</p> <p>Please complete <b>Questions 4-5</b>.</p>	<p>Please practise your 4 times tables.</p> <p>Maths homework book <b>page 14</b>. Please only complete <b>Questions 1-3</b>. The focus for this week is Multiplication.</p>  <p>We will go through the answers in class on <b>Thursday</b>.</p> <p>Please feel free to use any strategies to work out the answers.</p> <p>For example you may use counting on or back in your head, column method or use objects to support counting.</p>
